



# MASTERING FINANCIAL REPORTING

This 3-in-1 e-book/audiobook/videobook has been specifically designed for students in Financial Reporting at the foundational level. It does not address foundational financial accounting matters, such as the Accounting Equation, journals or ledgers, but assumes a working knowledge of those fundamentals. However, the book uses the Conceptual Framework for Financial Reporting as its point of departure. As such, the book is pitched at the second- or third-year level of studies in Accounting Sciences at most universities.

The book covers financial reporting specifically for companies or other corporate legal entities in a logical and chronological fashion. The links between various topics are addressed, as are certain auditing and tax implications. The aim is to train students for professional careers as accounting, auditing or tax practitioners.

The author has more than two decades of experience in accounting, auditing and tax practice, as well as almost two decades of experience as lecturer in Financial Accounting, Internal Auditing and External Auditing at various levels of study. During his academic career he had been the subject head of Auditing 2 and Internal Auditing 2, and was the subject head of Financial Accounting 1 and Financial Accounting 2 until his retirement at the end of 2025.
